First Baptist Church – Guymon, Oklahoma

First Baptist Church in Guymon, Oklahoma is currently seeking a full-time Worship Pastor who will join us in proclaiming the glory of God in Jesus Christ in the Panhandle of Oklahoma. The Worship Pastor will lead the congregation to glorify God in our worship, highlighting the glory of God in the Gospel of Jesus Christ through vocal and musical expressions of worship in our gathered community of faith. The Worship Pastor is a Pastor and recognized spiritual leader who works together with the other Pastors to fulfill our vision and priorities of biblical faithfulness. The Worship Pastor is also given primary responsibility in the area of the worship and music ministries of the church.

WHO WE ARE:

First Baptist Church is a Southern Baptist Church located in the rural area of the Oklahoma Panhandle with a long history of faithfulness. The church has its beginning in Native Oklahoma Territory in the early 1900's. Presently, our church is a multi-generational church with over 230 members and an average Sunday morning attendance around 200.

We exist to love God, love one another, and love the world for God's Glory. Our biblical priorities are God-centered worship, Word-centered teaching, Gospel-centered Evangelism, and Love-centered Fellowship. These are the core values that direct our church's worship and ministries.

Our corporate worship centers around the preaching of the Word of God, where deep songs of the faith function to engage our hearts in worship and prepare us for the biblical exposition of truth. In our worship services, we usually draw from the rich heritage of hymns found in our Baptist hymnal as well as modern hymns and songs that express a God-centered, Gospel-focused theology of expression of worship to God.

Biblical faithfulness to us includes a healthy church membership striving towards a gospel-centered, theologically driven ministry. This includes expositional preaching, deep worship, biblical church discipline, and meaningful and recognizable membership, the recognition of pastors as the spiritual leaders and shepherds of the church, and a heart for reaching both our neighborhood and the nations with the gospel.

There are presently 3 full-time pastors (preaching, family, and missions/discipleship) who are recognized as the spiritual leaders / shepherds of the church. We are looking for someone to join our team, share our vision and pursue faithfulness to God in the local church with us.

OUR AREA:

Guymon is primarily a farming and agricultural community, but it is also the largest city in the rural area of the Oklahoma Panhandle, population around 13,000. You can find most things you need in our community (Super Wal-Mart, grocery store, hardware store, doctors, etc.). However, when you need a larger city, the closest are Amarillo (2 hours away) and Oklahoma City (4 ½ hours away).

This small town community is also the most diverse in Oklahoma. The majority population is Hispanic in origin (52%). However, in addition to Hispanic-origin people, there are also significant and growing populations of Burmese, South Asian, Sudanese, Eritrean and West African peoples who come to the area to work in local beef or pork processing plants. We are excited about the gospel opportunities we have in our own community.
